

NOTICE OF CLASS ACTION: ISCO INDUSTRIES, INC. MARCH 2016 DATA BREACH

- The Spartanburg County Court of Common Pleas has certified a class action lawsuit against ISCO Industries, Inc. (“ISCO”). The case is *Davis v. ISCO Industries, Inc.*, C. A. No. 2017-CP-42-03283.
- If you are a current or former employee of ISCO whose personal identification information (“PII”) was released to cyber criminals as a result of the March 2016 Data Breach at ISCO, your rights may be affected by this class action lawsuit.
- The Court has appointed the law firms of John B. White, Jr. P.A. in Spartanburg and Simmons Law Firm, LLC in Columbia as Class Counsel. Class members are NOT responsible for paying the fees and expenses of Class Counsel.
- If you want to remain in the Class, you do not need to take any action at this time. If you do not want to be a part of the Class, you must exclude yourself (“opt out”) by December 5, 2025. If you opt out, you will not be eligible to receive any payments or benefits that might result at trial or settlement. Directions to opt out are at www.ISCODataBreach.com.
